

Regulations for the Selection and Appointment of the Director of the Graduate Institute of Taiwan History, National Taiwan Normal University

Passed at the 1st Institute General Meeting of the 2006 Academic Year Amended and Passed at the 1st Institute
General Meeting of the 2009 Academic Year

1. These Regulations are established in accordance with Article 13 of the University Act and Article 35 of the University Organizational Regulations.
2. The Director of the Institute shall be jointly selected by the full-time faculty members of the Institute. If the number of full-time faculty members is fewer than five, the Institute General Meeting may invite part-time faculty members of the Institute to make up the quorum.
3. The Director of the Institute shall be selected from among the Institute's full-time faculty members (including jointly appointed faculty) who hold the rank of Associate Professor or above and are under the age of 62. The selected candidate shall be reported to the President of the University for official appointment to the concurrent post.
4. The selection procedure for the Director of the Institute is as follows:

The selection of candidates for the Director of the Institute shall be conducted by secret ballot, with each ballot selecting one individual. Absentee voting by proxy is not permitted. The candidate who receives the highest number of votes, provided it constitutes at least one-half (inclusive) of the votes cast by the attendees, shall be declared the Director-elect. If the voting results do not meet the aforementioned requirement, subsequent rounds of voting shall be conducted in the same manner until the requirement is met.
5. The term of office for the Director of the Institute shall be three years. The Director may be eligible for re-election for one consecutive term.
6. The selection meeting for the Director of the Institute shall be convened by the incumbent Director two months prior to the expiration of their term. In the event that the position of Director becomes vacant mid-term, the Institute General Meeting shall elect one faculty member to serve as the convener, and

a selection meeting shall be convened within one month to elect a new Director.

7. Any matters not covered by these Regulations shall be amended and supplemented by the Institute General Meeting.
8. These Regulations shall be implemented upon approval by the Institute General Meeting and subsequent submission to the President of the University for record-keeping. The same procedure shall apply to any future amendments.
