

Directions for the Establishment of the Course Committee of the Graduate Institute of Taiwan History, National Taiwan Normal University

Passed at the 1st Extraordinary Institute General Meeting of the 2008 Academic Year on November 5, 2008
Amended and Passed at the 2nd Course Committee Meeting of the College of Liberal Arts for the 1st Semester of

Meeting for the 2nd Semester of the 2012 Academic Year on June 18, 2013 ---

1. These Directions are established in accordance with Paragraph 2, Item 3 of the "Directions for the Establishment of the Course Committee of National Taiwan Normal University."
2. The Course Committee of the Graduate Institute of Taiwan History, National Taiwan Normal University (hereinafter referred to as "the Committee") shall consist of three to five members. The Director of the Institute shall serve as an ex-officio member and the convener. In addition to the Director, the Committee must include at least two full-time faculty members of the Institute. Furthermore, one external expert/scholar and one to two student or alumnus representatives shall be invited to attend the meetings as non-voting participants.
3. The responsibilities of the Committee are as follows:
 - (1) To review and improve the curriculum of the Institute.
 - (2) To evaluate and review newly proposed courses of the Institute.
4. The Committee shall convene at least one meeting each semester; extraordinary meetings may be called when necessary.
5. These Directions shall be implemented upon review and approval by the College Course Committee and subsequent submission to the University Course Committee for record-keeping. The same procedure shall apply to any future amendments.
